

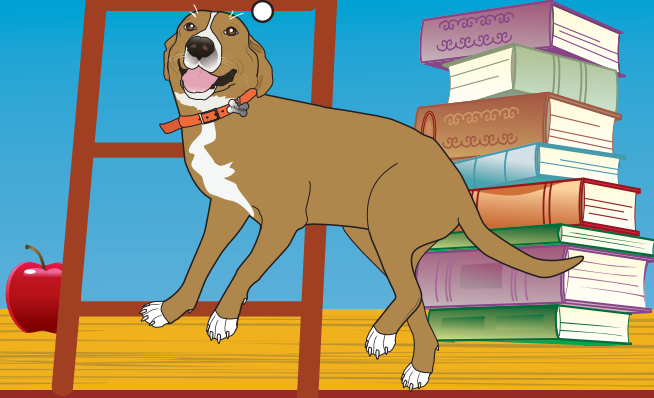
REBUS STORY

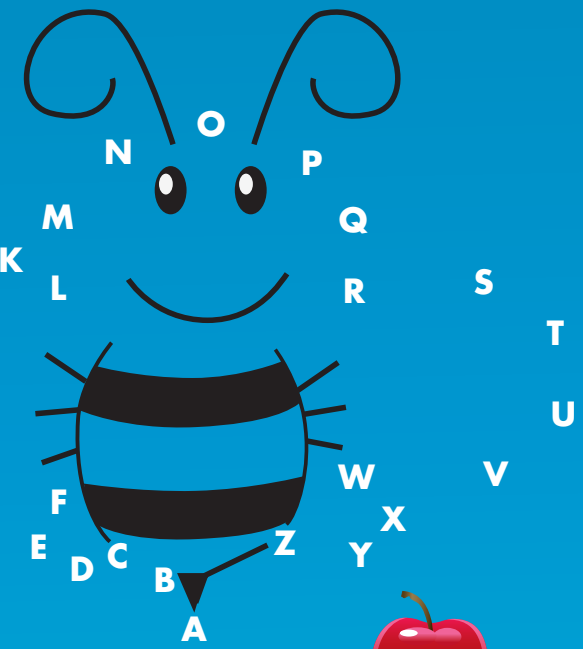


This word is fun to sound out:

CAN YOU FIND and circle all 8 apples?

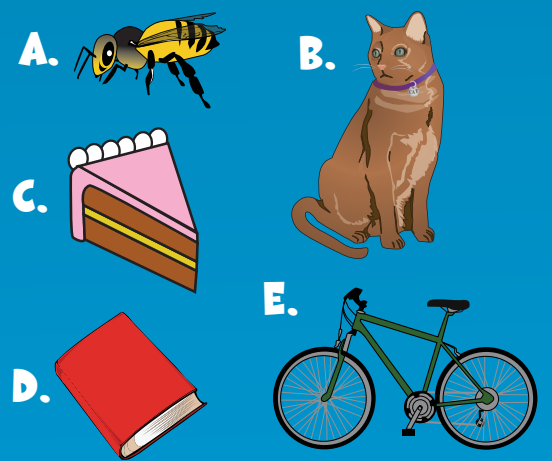
